



Dr. Brijesh Rathi is currently working as Professor at Hansraj College, University of Delhi. He is the Head of Centre for International Programmes and H. G. Khorana Centre For Chemical Biology. He earned his doctoral degree from University of Delhi and post-doctoral research with Prof. Alexander Klibanov's research group at Massachusetts Institute of Technology (M.I.T.), USA. Dr Rathi has received several prestigious honors & awards, including the 'Excellence Award for In-Service Teachers' (2018), 'Institution of Eminence Fellow from University of Delhi, 2022, and Visiting Fellowship Award (2024) from the National Center for Infectious Diseases (NCID), Singapore. He was also awarded the CAPES-Print Fellowship twice (Brazil, 2019/2024), the Early Career Research Award (2016), and DST-Young Scientist Fellowship (2010). He also received 'Research Excellence Award' twice from Hansraj College, University of Delhi for his intriguing contribution to the institution. As an Affiliate Professor at University of Debrecen, Hungary and University of Loyola Chicago, he has taught international credit courses on drug discovery.

He has supervised seven doctoral scholars, mentored over forty undergraduate/post-graduate students and six post-doctoral researchers. With more than 135 publications and four patents (two national, two international), he also serves as Associate Editor of 'Chemical Biology Letters' (IF 6.9, 2024; Scopus Q1) since last five years. He is the co-founder of start-up company, HeteroChem InnoTech Private Limited and Open Knowledge Foundation (OKF).
