Please adjust your final submission style according to the IEEE standard double column format. The final paper can be a maximum of 6 pages.

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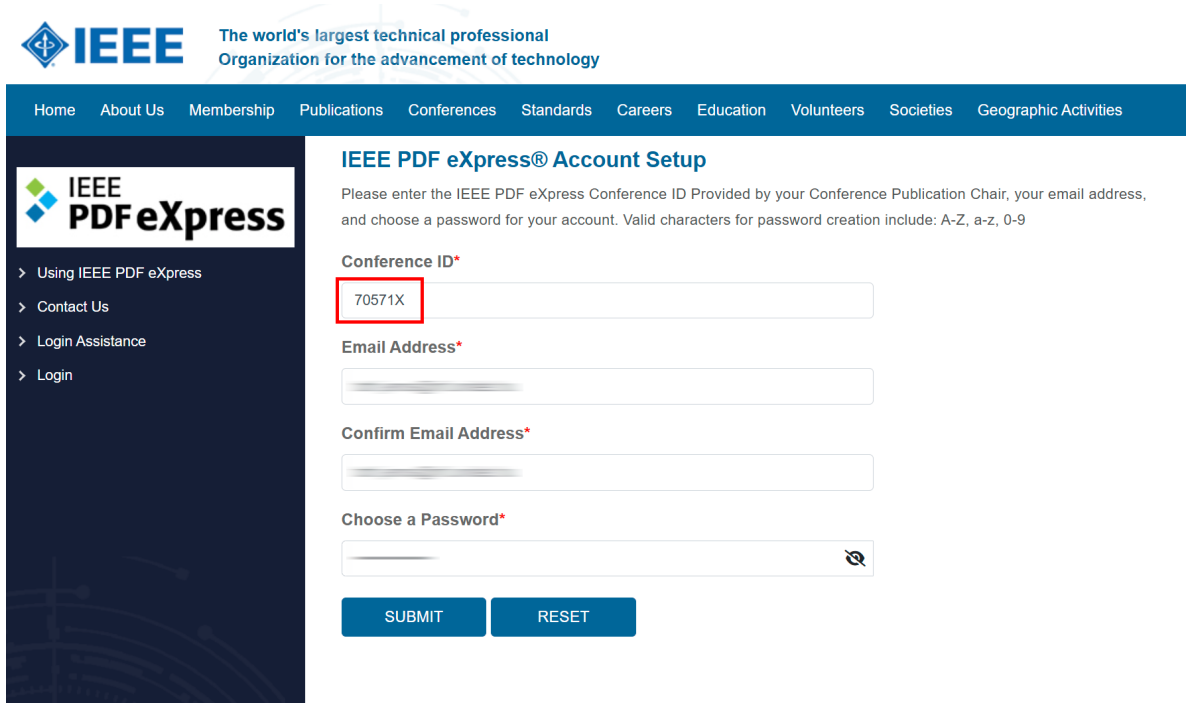
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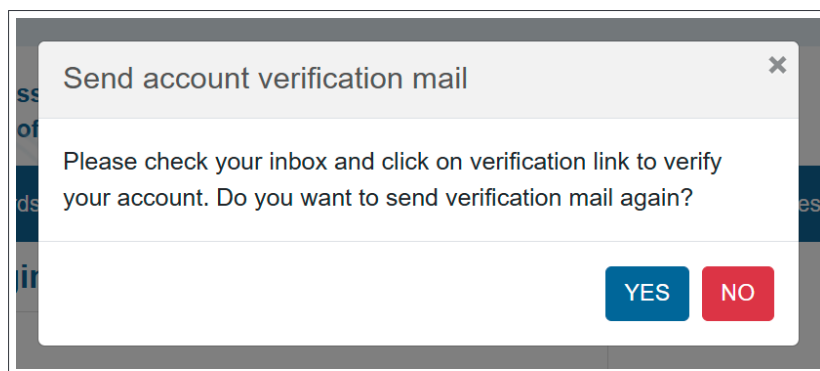
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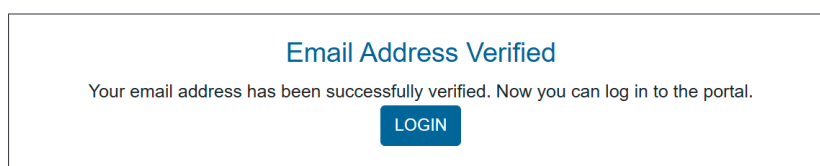


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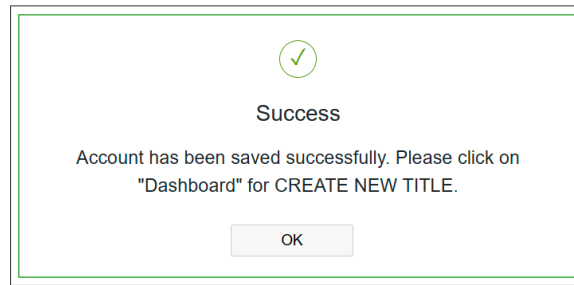


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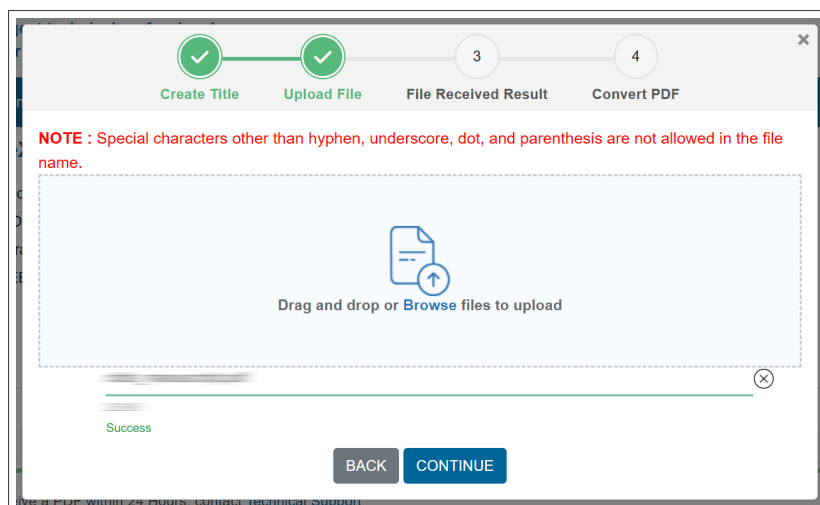
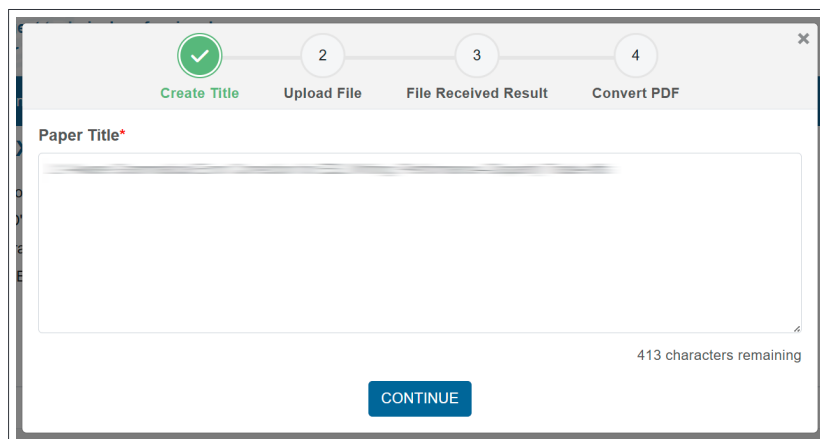
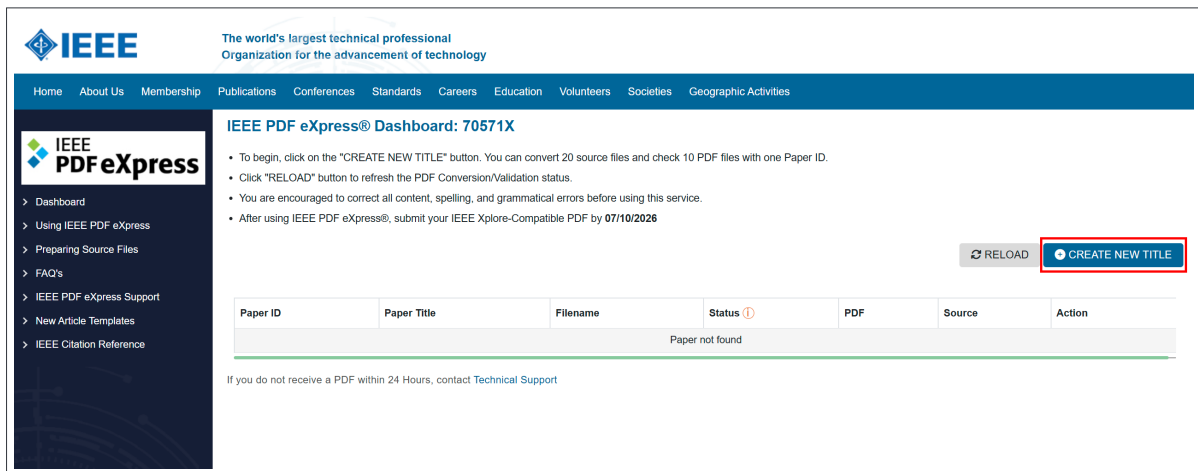


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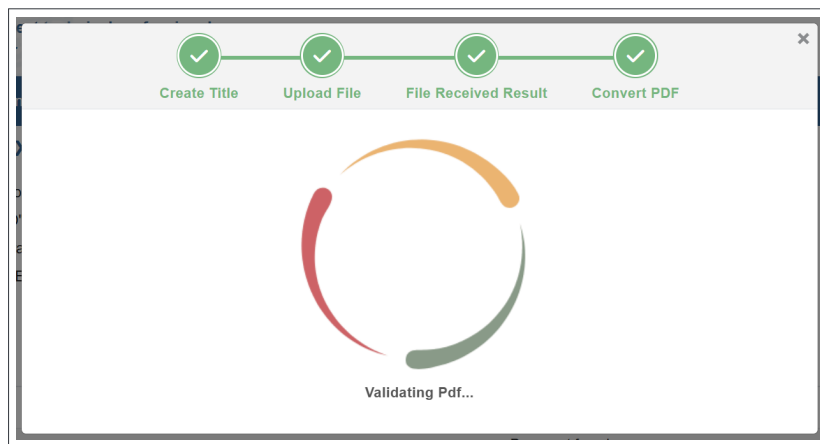
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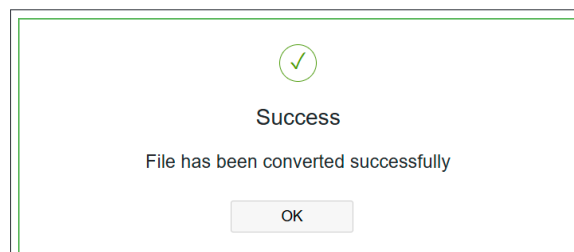
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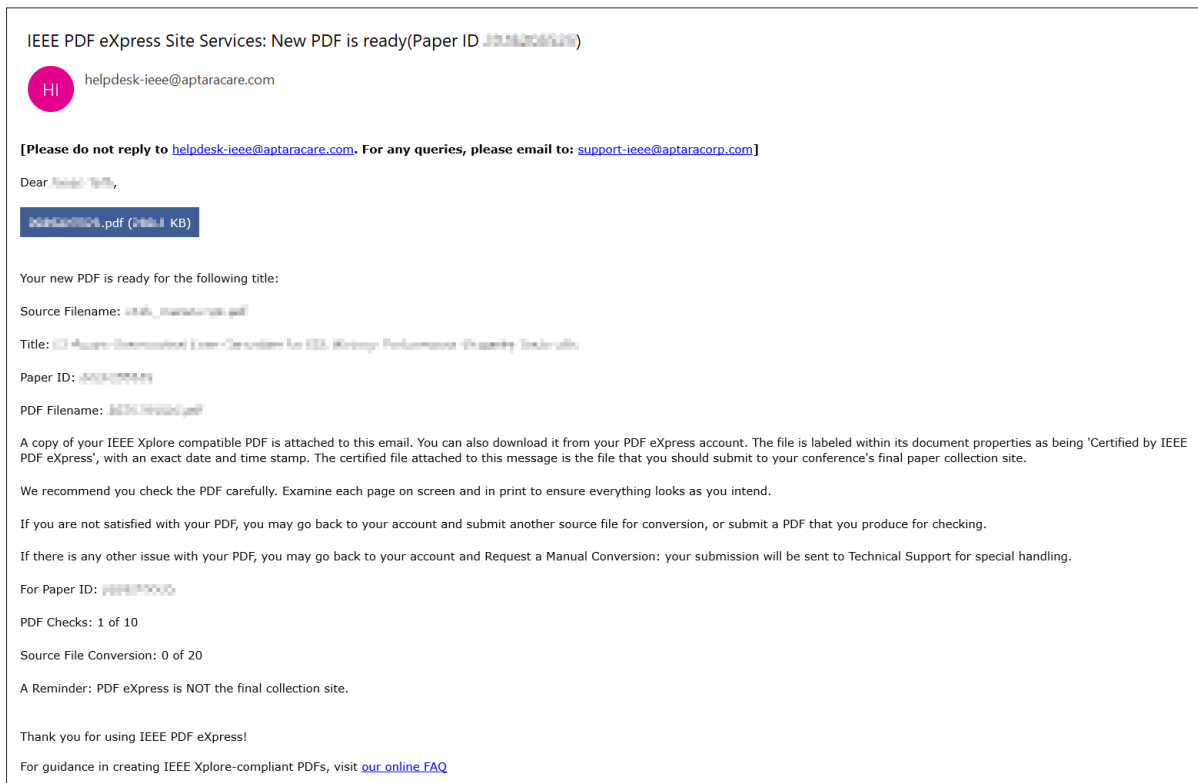
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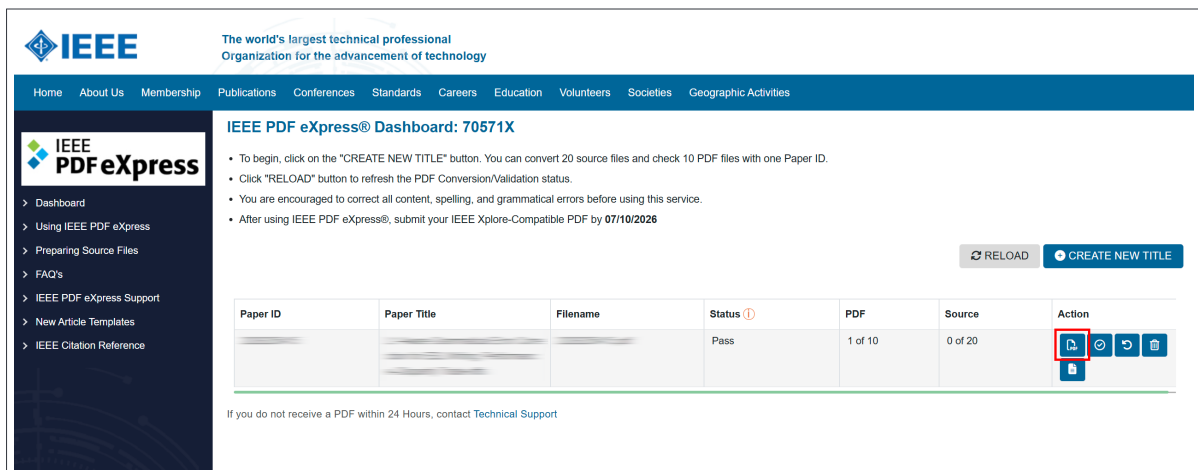
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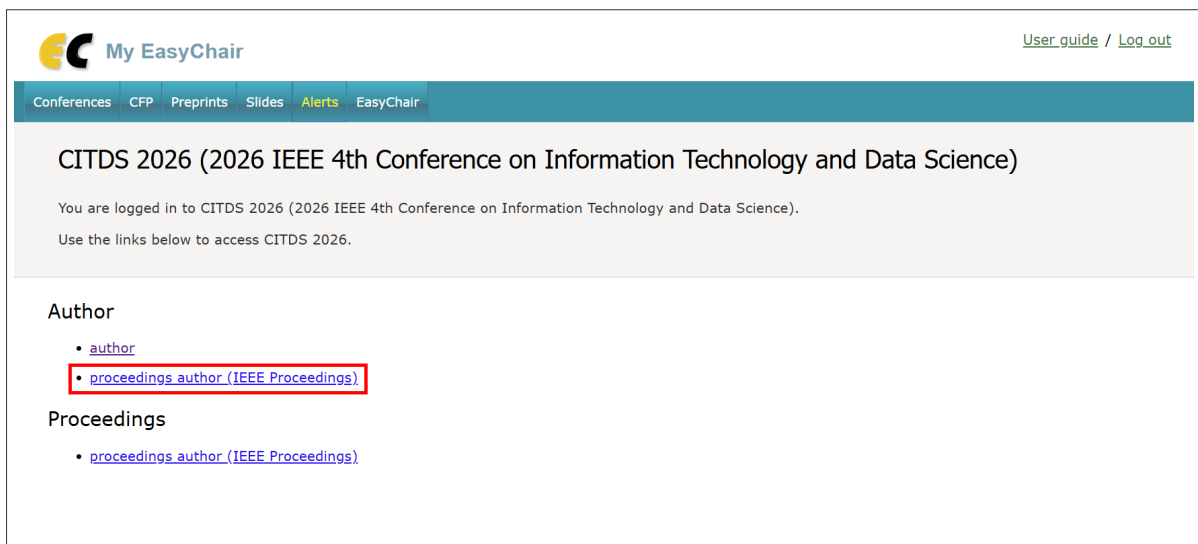
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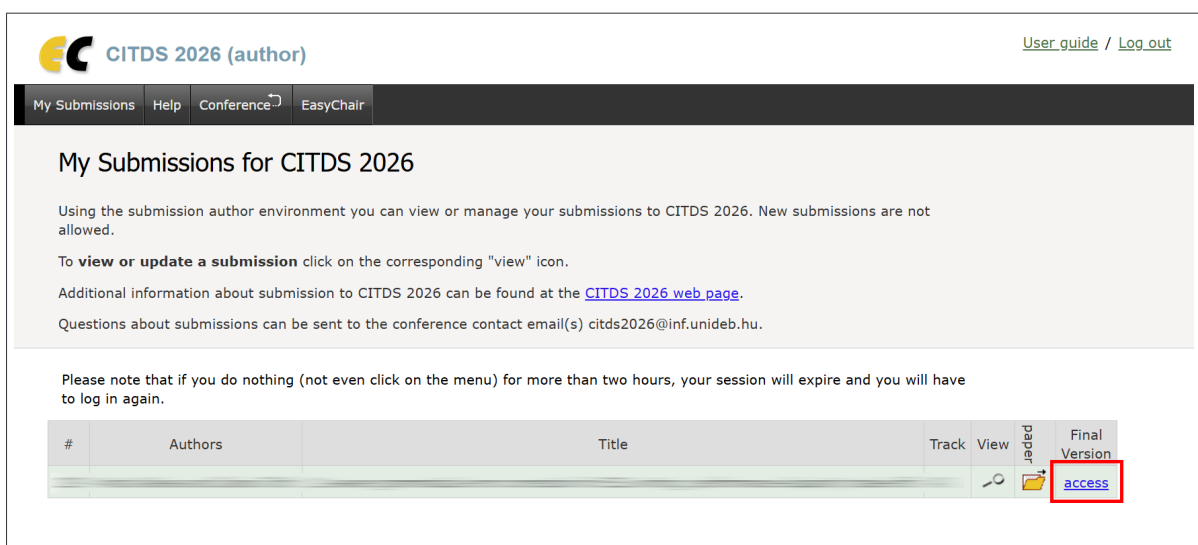
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
