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Professor de Oliveira's research interests include organic synthesis and medicinal chemistry, focusing on heterocyclic compounds, carbohydrate derivatives, and glycerol-based molecules with biological activities against parasites, bacteria, and viruses, including *Leishmania*, malaria parasites, *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, SARS-CoV-2, Zika, and Chikungunya viruses. He has advised 14 master's and 11 Ph.D. students and authored 67 peer-reviewed scientific publications.
