

Dr. Seonghun Kim is a Principal Research Scientist at Korea Research Institute of Bioscience & Biotechnology (KRIBB) and a Professor at University of Science and Technology (UST), which is belonging to National Research Council of Science and Technology (NST) in Korea. He received his PhD from Pohang University of Science and Technology (POSTECH) KOREA in 2005. He also conducted research in 2005-2010 as a postdoc at KRIBB in KOREA and at Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH-Zürich) in Switzerland. After joining KRIBB in 2010, he and his team have been focusing their research on applied glycobiology, glycobiotechnology, and lectinology for host-microbiome glycan interaction using fungal resources. He has published 50 international peer reviewed papers with 1360 citations (H-Index 24) as reported in SCOPUS and over 20 issued and pending patents.
